All mail must be left with <u>no acceptance signature required</u>. Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations MUST be received **by email** (preferred) or **in legible writing** prior to the May 15 closing date, or no refund will be issued. No telephone changes accepted. No refunds for entry form errors made by the entrant.

Entries not on official entry forms, or photocopies of entry forms, without the Release Form on the reverse side of the entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging.

Entries can also be made via fax or email, or online, with payment made via PayPal or credit card. Fax entries are to be sent to 262-500-4080. Email entries are to be sent to secretary@caper-dogs. com. To pay for these entries, you must go to www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm and follow the directions there; incorrect fees will render the entry invalid.

Online entries click HERE. Payment is made through PayPal (credit/debit cards can also be used).

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. Confirmations and judging schedules will be emailed after closing. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from the competition by actions of the Trial Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disturbance, fire or Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the club. Withdrawals of bitches in season will receive full refunds if notice is given to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the day's judging. Overpayments of less than \$5 will not be refunded.

There will be NO moveups in level between Trial 1 and Trial 2.

General Information

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to Belgian Tervuren 6 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

RINGSIDE: These trials will be running concurrently with the agility trials each day. Reasonable accomodations will be made for teams running in both agility and scentwork, but conflicts need to be communicated to the gate stewards in both sports as soon as possible.

SAFETY/BEHAVIOR: The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal & external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

COLLARS, LEASHES AND HARNESSES: During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

LIABILITY: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. ABTC and their agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children. ABTC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against ABTC, the American Kennel Club, or any official thereof.

Site Information

GENERAL: The Scent Work trials will be held concurrently with Agility. Crating will be available indoors in the middle of the Roberts Ring hall, with Scent Work on one end and Agility on the other end. There should be plenty of room for everyone if space is conserved wisely.

NO grooming areas will be available on Monday or Tuesday!

CHECK-IN & BRIEFING: There will not be an in-person general briefing in the morning. Check-in will be at the gate of each element search.

HANDLER'S BRIEFINGS: Briefings for searches will be done for each person prior to the start of the search. More information will be made available in the confirmation/judging schedule email sent after closing.

TRIAL ORDER: Timing/order of classes will be dependent on entry numbers and will be in the judging schedule.

WARM UP: Warm up/Recovery boxes will be available for searches. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to one minute or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior to their search, or for recovery after the search. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

SPECTATORS are welcome at the discretion of the judge and individual teams. Not all search areas will have the space to allow spectators. The best way to watch is by volunteering!

VOLUNTEERS: We will need personnel to help staff the trial. Please consider volunteering for one or more classes. Contact Nancy McClure, monarchterv@comcast.net, to sign up!

POSSESSION OF ODORS AND TRAINING: Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area."

SEARCH AREA CONDITIONS: Searches may be indoors on concrete, tile, matting, or carpeted surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

1st - 4th place – Ribbon (1st Blue, 2nd Red, 3rd Yellow, 4th White) Qualifying runs – Dark Green Ribbon

Trial 2 - National Trial

High in Trial awards require the dog to be entered in the same level (Novice, Advanced, Excellent, Master) for both Interior and Container elements, and receive a qualifying score in both elements. The winner at each level is awarded a rosette and a Terv-themed item.

High Combined awards require the dog to be entered in the same level (Novice, Advanced, Excellent, Master) for both Interior and Container elements PLUS Handler Discrimination, and receive a qualifying score in all 3 runs. The winner at each level is awarded a rosette and a Terv-themed item.

Placement ribbons or rosettes will be awarded to first (Blue), second (Red), third (Yellow) and fourth (White) places in each level of each element.

Dark Green qualifying ribbons or rosettes will be awarded to passing scores.

New Title rosettes will be available to all teams finishing a title.
