Entry form changes, additions, corrections and cancellations MUST be received **by email** (preferred) or **in legible writing** prior to the May 15 closing date, or no refund will be issued. No telephone changes accepted. No refunds for entry form errors made by the entrant.

Entries not on official entry forms, or photocopies of entry forms, without the Release Form on the reverse side of the entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging.

Entries can also be made via fax or email, or online, with payment made via PayPal or credit card. Fax entries are to be sent to 262-500-4080. Refunds: After the closing date, bitches who come into season will have entry fees refunded in full, and dogs who become ill/injured with a vet note will have fees refunded less \$8/run, if notice is given to the trial secretary ≥ 30 minutes prior to the start of judging. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from the competition by actions of the Trial Committee. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riot, civil disturbance, fire or Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the club. Overpayments of less than \$5 will not be refunded.

<u>Moveups</u> to a higher level will be accepted prior to the trial until Monday June 3, 6pm CDT. Requests must be in writing (email preferred); NO telephone moveups allowed. Moveups for Tuesday must be submitted within 30 minutes after the end of Monday's trial. NO moveups Tuesday morning!

Trial Information

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number (for mixed breed dogs), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Entries limited to Belgian Tervuren on Tuesday.**

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All measurements are at the dog's withers.

MEASURING: All dogs participating in this trial must have an AKC height card or they will need to be measured prior to running. At least one VMO will be in attendance to measure for officialheight cards. It is the owner's responsibility to have the dog measured prior to running. Awards may be cancelled if the dog is not measured before running.

RINGSIDE: Agility Gate will be used to manage the running orders. On Tuesday Agility will be running concurrently with the Scent Work trials. Reasonable accommodations will be made for teams running in both agility and scent work, but conflicts need to be communicated to the gate stewards in both sports as soon as possible.

SAFETY/BEHAVIOR: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

LIABILITY: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. ABTC and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children. ABTC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against ABTC, the American Kennel Club, or any official thereof.

Mixed Entries, FEO, & Fix N Go Information

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend & Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifiesin Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO is of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors who are having difficulty with a specificobstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the trial.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of trial jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not
 eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on
 the start line. Day of trial level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- · Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- · Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefitof the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go (FNG)

Fix and Go allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to suc-cessfully complete the obstacle then finishthe course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Run for Glory

This non-competitive event is being held to recognize our beloved retired agility dogs.

The event will be held Tuesday June 11, immediately before Novice JWW during the Tervuren specialty agility trial. Each dog will run a "victory" course based on novice JWW obstacles, with bars set at the handler's height choice or left on the ground. Any obstacles may be skipped.

This year's theme will be "Boundless Agility." While the titles of these dogs document success, no titles can adequately reflect the journey that brought us to those achievements. Please provide one or two short moments that personify your relationship with your dog. Those memories will be read aloud by the announcer for all to share, while you and your dog enjoy the Run for Glory course. At the conclusion of the run, each team will receive a personalized ribbon with their dog's name and titles embossed on it.

This special event is for retired dogs only, regardless of how long they have been retired. The deadline is April 10th to allow time for ordering the custom ribbons. No entries can be made after this date.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes <u>must</u> compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the **AKC Canine Partners**SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner?
